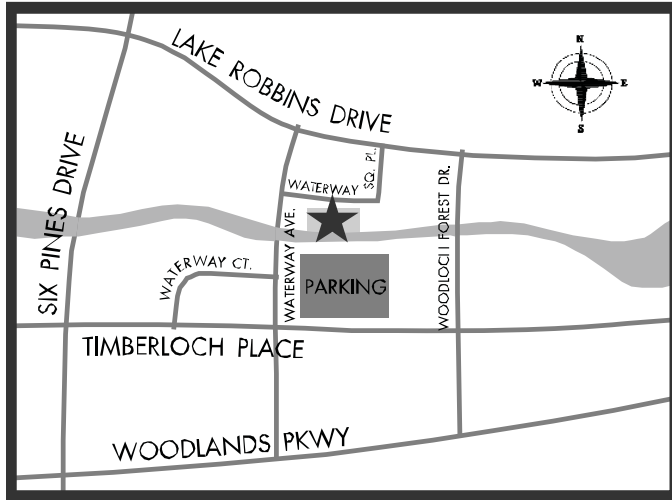


Fall 2009 Waterway Square Programs
